### **Introductory Symposium**

This one day course introduces students with no prior knowledge of investment banking to the key business areas of the firm through presentations and interactive sessions. Networking opportunities with industry professionals are also built into the tailor made schedule to allow personal exploration of the diversity and culture of the firm. Following the event participants are encouraged to apply to either first year, or internship programmes to find out more.

### **EmployAbility Internship for Students with Disabilities (EI)**

The Goldman Sachs EmployAbility internship gives first and penultimate year students with disabilities the opportunity to obtain invaluable work experience and gain an insight into the industry. Candidates apply through EmployAbility\* but each applicant is assessed against Goldman Sachs core competencies and selected through the Goldman Sachs recruitment process. Successful candidates are hired directly into one of our established Spring or Summer Programmes and are completely integrated into every aspect of the division's internship programme.

A firmwide taskforce including Diversity Recruiting, EmployAbility and Access to Work (a government run organisation) ensures all reasonable adjustments the students require are in place, provides disability awareness training for employees and supports the interns during their internship.

\*EmployAbility is a not for profit organisation that facilitates and manages the recruitment and selection of people with disabilities seeking internships and full time work.

Opportunities are available in various divisions throughout the firm, including but not limited to: Finance (Controllers, Corporate Treasury, Credit); Human Capital Management; Investment Banking; Investment Management; Operations; Securities; and Technology.
